

Help for Data Quality Score report

The DQS is a single combined score for the flock, evaluating data from the last 5 years. This score is provided as a value out of 100, where the higher the value the better the data quality, and as a star rating that reflects the range in which your score fits. For example, a 4 star rating refers to a DQS that sits between 60 and 80, out of 100.

Data Quality Score: This ranges from 0 to 100, where flocks with higher scores have better quality data.

DQS Star Rating: Star rating from 1 to 5, where 5 star rating flocks have better quality data. Star ratings are allocated depending on the score. 1 star: Score 0 – 20, 2 star: Score 21 – 40, 3 star: Score 41 – 60, 4 star: Score 61 – 80, 5 star: Score 81 – 100.

DQS Distribution: This graph shows you where you sit compared to other flocks. The graph also tells you the distribution of other flock's scores – how spread out the scores are and the number of flocks for each given star rating (shown in different colours).



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
